
Approval of the minutes from regular meeting on March 6, 2019

Mayor's Update

New Business:

1. Adopt the General Alimony Millage Rate of 5.150 mills for the tax year 2019.
2. Authorize Mayor Ardoin to sign the "demolition contracts" for the condemned properties in Town.
3. Authorize Mayor Ardoin to purchase two (2) Ford F-150 pickup trucks as follows: (1) 2018 Ford F-150 pickup, VIN-1FTEW1CB1JKF95633 (\$24,930.25); and (1) 2018 Ford F-150 pickup, VIN-1FTEX1CB6JKF16728 (\$21,909.25), which total \$46,839.50, using the escrow funds held under financing agreement 7516.
4. Adopt Resolution authorizing Mayor Ardoin to enter into a Lease Purchase Agreement with Government Capital to purchase three (3) Dodge Durango police units, totaling \$89,904.75.
5. Authorize Mayor Ardoin to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with St. Landry Parish Solid Waste Disposal District to receive the sum of \$20,031.00 of surplus funds for street repairs and/or drainage projects related to street repairs.
6. Condemn the property located at 912 Saizan Avenue, upon the recommendation of Building Code Inspection Services.

7. Condemn the property located at 170 Josie Street, upon the recommendation of Building Code Inspection Services.
8. Condemn the property located at 161 Lydia Street, upon the recommendation of Building Code Inspection Services.
9. Adopt the Louisiana Municipal Water Pollution Prevention (MWPP) plan, prepared by CENLA Environmental, for the year 2018, and submit to DEQ.
10. Adopt a Resolution granting Mayor Ardoin permission to sign and submit all necessary documents, appoint an administrative consultant and engineer and to commit costs for the FY 2020-2021 LCDBG program.
11. Call on Chief Boudreaux.
12. Call on Parks and Recreation Director.
13. Call on Utility/Street Department Supervisor.
14. Accept all financial and departmental reports.
15. Call on Town Council, then members of the audience.
