COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

APRIL 7, 2026

REGULAR MEETING

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Alderswoman of the Town of Port Barre met in regular session in the town hall on Tuesday, April 7, 2026, at the hour of 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Ardoin called the meeting to order. Present were: Robin, S. Hardy and G. Hardy. Absent: Hebert and Kimble.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Alderswoman of the Town of Port Barre, Parish of St. Landry, State of Louisiana, were duly convened as the governing authority of said town by Mayor John P. Ardoin, whom stated that the Council was ready for the transaction of business.

Motion by Robin, seconded by G. Hardy, accepting the minutes of the Regular Meeting held on March 3, 2026, and to dispense with the reading thereof. Unanimous.

Motion by S. Hardy, seconded by Robin to go into Executive Session regarding personnel matters. Unanimous. Council went into Executive Session at approximately 6:10 p.m.

Motion by S. Hardy, seconded by Robin to return to Regular Session. Unanimous. Council returned to Regular Session at approximately 6:22 p.m.

Motion by Robin, seconded by S. Hardy to accept the resignation of Officer Davonthae Thomas. Unanimous.

Motion by S. Hardy, seconded by Robin adopting the General Alimony millage rate of 5.130 mills for tax year 2026. Unanimous.

Motion by G. Hardy, seconded by S. Hardy adopting the fiscal year October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2025 audit presented by the accounting firm of Kolder, Slaven & Company. Unanimous.

Town Clerk Toria V. Comeaux opened the bids for the demolition and clean-up of the property located at 125 Josie Street. Four bids were received as follows: (1) Daniel K. Soileau, LLC - \$3,995.00; (2) Bayou State Containers, LLC - \$3,850.00; Southern Land Renovations, LLC - \$5,335.00; and Collins Property Maintenance, LLC - \$4,442.00.

Motion by Robin, seconded by G. Hardy to accept the bid of Bayou State Containers, LLC in the amount of \$3,850.00. Unanimous.

Mayor Ardoin called upon Chief Boudreaux, who rendered the monthly report of Police Department activities.

Mayor Ardoin called upon Superintendent Greg Leger who gave an update on public works activities.

Mayor Ardoin called upon Parks & Recreation Director Kyla Rivette who gave an update on Youth League activities.

Motion by S. Hardy, seconded by Robin accepting all financial and departmental reports. Unanimous.

Mayor Ardoin called upon the Town Council, then the audience. General discussion was had, including water leak on the corner of Robin Street and Saizan Avenue, beehive located at the corner of Choctaw Street and Saizan Avenue, gas line extension on Rayne Road and gas leaks. Alderman S. Hardy introduced Ordinance No. 1 of 2026, Authority of Magistrate to Adjust Traffic Tickets to Non-Moving Violations.

Motion by S. Hardy, seconded by Robin to adjourn. Unanimous.
