COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

DECEMBER 2, 2025

REGULAR MEETING

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Alderwoman of the Town of Port Barre met in regular session in the town hall on Tuesday, December 2, 2025, at the hour of 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Ardoin called the meeting to order. Present were: Hebert, Robin, Kimble, S. Hardy and G. Hardy. Absent: None.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Alderwoman of the Town of Port Barre, Parish of St. Landry, State of Louisiana, were duly convened as the governing authority of said town by Mayor John P. Ardoin, whom stated that the Council was ready for the transaction of business.

Motion by Hebert, seconded by S. Hardy, accepting the minutes of the Regular Meetings held on November 4, 2025, and to dispense with the reading thereof. Unanimous.

Motion by S. Hardy, seconded by Kimble setting the public meeting dates for the year 2026 as follows: Tuesday, January 6; February 3; March 3; April 7; May 5; June 2; July 7; August 4; September 1; October 6; November 3; December 1. Unanimous.

Motion by Robin, seconded by S. Hardy adopting a Resolution authorizing Mayor John P. Ardoin to sign and submit applications to the State of Louisiana, Office of Community Development, for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 LGAP and CWEF grant programs. Unanimous.

Mayor Ardoin called upon Chief Boudreaux, who rendered the monthly report of Police Department activities. He also reminded everyone about the upcoming Senior Luncheon on December 12, 2025 and Christmas Parade on December 20, 2025.

Mayor Ardoin called upon Superintendent Greg Leger who gave an update on public works activities, including the upgrade project at the water distribution site.


Mayor Ardoin called upon Parks and Recreation Director Kyla Rivette. Ms. Rivette was not present. Mayor Ardoin gave an update on Youth League activities, and advised that the flag football season had ended and that basketball registrations were under way.

Motion by Robin, seconded by S. Hardy accepting all financial and departmental reports. Unanimous.

Mayor Ardoin called upon the town council, then the audience. General discussion was had, including the lights needed repairing at the Saizan Avenue ball field, sign for the front of the Town Hall, ditches and trash, and the sidewalk project.

Motion by S. Hardy, seconded by Hebert to adjourn. Unanimous.
