REGULAR MEETING

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Alderwoman of the Town of Port Barre met in regular session in the town hall on Tuesday, May 2, 2023, at the hour of 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Ardoin called the meeting to order. Present were: Robin, Hebert, Kimble and G. Hardy. Absent: S. Hardy.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Alderwoman of the Town of Port Barre, Parish of St. Landry, State of Louisiana, were duly convened as the governing authority of said town by Mayor John P. Ardoin, whom stated that the Council was ready for the transaction of business.

Motion by Robin, seconded by Hebert, accepting the minutes of the Regular Meeting held on April 4, 2023, and to dispense with the reading thereof. Unanimous.

Mayor Ardoin gave an update on business items from the April 4, 2023 meeting.

Motion by Robin, seconded by Kimble adopting the General Alimony Millage Rate of 5.150 mills for tax year 2023. Unanimous.

Motion by G. Hardy, seconded by Hebert grating permission to Mayor Ardoin to restart the "brick paver project" in Veterans Memorial Park. Unanimous.

Mayor Ardoin called upon Chief Deon Boudreaux, who rendered the monthly report of Police Department activities. He also gave an update on the "Second Harvest" food pantry, the department's new Facebook page and the Youth Mentoring Program.

Mayor Ardoin called upon Superintendent Greg Leger who gave an update on public works activities.

Mayor Ardoin gave an update on the Youth League's baseball/softball program, and advised that the Parks and Recreation Director tendered his resignation.

Motion by Robin, seconded by Kimble accepting all financial and departmental reports. Unanimous.

Mayor Ardoin called upon the Council, then the audience. General discussion was had, including the Veterans Memorial Park brick paver project, water system upgrades and the Town's procurement of additional property at the well site, park improvements, including the construction of a new restroom facility, ditches and draining, and street improvements.
